If you need to add someone to the list please come in person to make the necessary changes. This is for the safety of all students.
- Program ends at 5:45 pm. If you will be picking up your child, please be on time. We understand that on occasion emergencies arise, however, please call to notify.
- Please update all contact information. It is important that we are able to contact you in case of an emergency.
- Students are expected to follow their school's code of conduct. Frequent disruptions may result in removal from program. All staff will follow an appropriate behavior intervention plan.
